## INDIVIDUAL • \$65

All members and staff of boards, commissions, and agencies who are responsible for parole practices as they relate to release decision-making, reentry, supervision following release, and revocation of release, may apply for individual membership. Individual members are entitled to all member benefits, and are eligible to vote, serve on standing or ad hoc committees and serve on the Executive Committee.

## ORGANIZATIONAL • \$375 – \$875

All members and staff of boards, commissions, and agencies who are responsible for parole practices as they relate to release decision-making, reentry, supervision following release, and revocation of release, may be grouped into an organizational membership. Organizational members are entitled to all member benefits, and are eligible to vote, serve on standing or ad hoc committees, and serve on the Executive Committee.

## CORPORATE • \$1000

All business entities wishing to support the mission of APAI may apply for corporate Membership and will be entitled to all benefits of APAI, and may serve on standing or ad hoc committees, however they shall not be eligible to vote or serve on the Executive Committee.

## ASSOCIATE • \$40

All organizations, academicians, researchers, and individuals who have an interest in parole practices as they relate to release decision-making, reentry, supervision following release, and revocation of release, may apply for associate Membership. Associate members will be entitled to all benefits of the APAI, and may serve on standing or ad hoc committees, however they shall not be eligible to vote or serve on the Executive Committee.

## STUDENT • \$15

All students who have an interest in parole practices as they relate to release decision-making, reentry, supervision following release, and revocation of release, may apply for student membership. Student members will be entitled to all benefits of APAI, and may serve on standing or ad hoc committees, however, they shall not be eligible to vote or serve on the Executive Committee.

## ALUMNI • \$40

All former Organizational and Individual members of APAI may apply for alumni membership. Alumni members are entitled to all member benefits and are eligible to vote, may serve on standing and ad hoc committees, and shall be eligible to serve on the Executive Committee, as appointed by the President.
